

Bat Regulations – Summer/Fall Season 2012

City of South San Francisco

- All legal, ASA approved softball bats must be tested by the League Director to be used during game play.
- If a bat passes the compression test it will be given an official ASA 2012 sticker. Once a sticker is placed onto a bat it should not be moved.
- Any bat that does not have an official ASA 2012 sticker will not be allowed into the league or game play.
- Umpires do have the authority to examine whether a sticker has been tampered with or transferred to another bat.
- Any bat with a sticker that has been declared invalid by the umpire may not be used in a game.
- League Director has the right to re-test any bat during the course of the season.
- During a game, if a bat is noticed to be in-valid by the opposing team or umpire after the ball was put into play and before the next batter begins there at bat, the batter will be declared “OUT” and all runners must return to their original base.
- Below is a picture of what a tampered sticker looks like compared to an originally placed sticker.
 - **Not Valid**
 - Hexagon shaped figures present.
 - ASA hologram logo faint or gone
 - **Valid**
 - Orange color
 - Year matches current season
 - Smooth looking surface
- The City of Burlingame and the City of South San Francisco will accept the below stickers from either City’s Adult Softball Program for players who may participate in both leagues.
